



## **DIRECTIONS TO GOURDON FROM TOULOUSE AIRPORT**

From the airport follow signs to Toulouse.

You will find yourself on the A621 signposted in BLUE to:

Toulouse-Centre  
Bordeaux  
Limoges  
Albi

After five minutes or so you'll arrive at the "périphérique", which is the ring road around Toulouse. Follow BLUE signs for:

A620 / E72  
Périphérique Intérieur  
Bordeaux  
Paris  
Albi

Stay on the "périphérique" for another five minutes and then take the exit marked with a BLUE sign for:

A62 / E9 / E72  
Bordeaux  
Paris

At the toll booth, or "péage", take a ticket.

You are now on the A62 motorway heading for Bordeaux. After around twenty minutes take the exit marked with a blue sign for:

A20 / E9  
Paris  
Limoges  
Montauban



Pay at the toll booth. Avoid the lanes marked with an orange lower-case “t” only, as they don’t accept cash or credit cards. If there’s a green arrow, either by itself or if it also has an orange “t”, then you’re OK. If a lane has “CB” over it, it takes credit cards only.

For the next 10-15 minutes, you are on a link road taking you to the A20 motorway for Paris.

Watch out! The speed limit on this section is 90 km/h.

At the toll booth, take a ticket.

You are now on the A20 motorway heading for Paris. After around forty-five minutes take the exit marked with a WHITE sign for:

Sortie 56  
Aurillac  
Sarlat  
Gourdon  
etc.

Pay at the toll booth.

At the roundabout, take the third exit:

D801  
Payrac  
Gourdon

Stay on this road, following signposts to Gourdon, for twenty minutes or so.

You have arrived!
